Application Instructions for a Court Ordered Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title

Disclaimer:

1. This information is to be used only if the applicant is a resident of Wood County
2. This guide to obtain a court ordered title has been compiled for purposes of providing an example only. Please consult with your legal counsel, as the Clerk of Courts is not authorized to provide legal advice!
3. All information as to locations, hours of operation, fees and processes are accurate, as we know it upon the delivery of this packet to you.
4. Finally, This process does not guarantee a Certificate of Title will be court ordered. Once the process has been submitted to the Court, it is their discretion for the final approval.

Requesting the Court to order the issuance of a certificate of title is an available remedy if any of the following limited circumstances exist:

Lost or Stolen Title: The certificate of title is lost or stolen and a duplicate is no longer available from the Wood County Title Department. The required application/affidavit must be filed by the party requesting the duplicate title. The applicant must conduct a record search for “last known address” and “title lien holder information” on the active title

Incomplete Sale: There is proof of the transaction and the previous owner of record has not provided the certificate of title. Documentation must be submitted showing there has been an effort made, by certified mail, to contact the prior owner requesting a title to be provided. The applicant must conduct a record search for “last known address” and “title lien holder information” on the active title.

Repair Garage or Place of Storage: Only when the value of the vehicle exceeds \$3500.00, after the deduction of repair costs, can the court consider a request for an order. If the value of the vehicle is less than \$3500.00, the owner of the repair garage or place of storage may obtain a title by completing BMV Form 4202 – Unclaimed Motor Vehicle Affidavit.

Application Instructions for a Court Ordered Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title

- If after you have presented all documents and evidence to the **Wood County Title Office** including a pencil tracing or a digital picture of the VIN# (Vehicle Identification Number) of the vehicle and the evidence is sufficient, the Title Office will issue a Certificate of Title.

If the documentation is insufficient and the Title Office is unable to process a Title; you will be provided a “Court Ordered Title packet” and you will need to follow the process listed below:

- You are required to provide a pencil tracing or a digital picture of the VIN # (Vehicle Identification Number) of the vehicle.
- Submit OBMV’s Record Request (BMV Form #1173) for search for “Last Known Address” and “Copy of Title Record”. The fee to search both is \$10.00. Make a check out to the Ohio Treasurer of State for \$10.00 and mail form and payment to the address on the bottom of the form.
- A deputy clerk will sign the request form for the **Ohio State Highway Patrol** to inspect the vehicle after the customer has filled out the pertinent information (name & VIN number) of the vehicle in question.
- Applicant will need to obtain and pay for from the Deputy Registrar’s office, located at 1616 E Wooster Street, Unit # 30, Bowling Green, OH 43402 a “**Salvage Inspection Receipt**”. Cost for the inspection is approximately \$55.00.
- You are required to make an appointment for the OSHP inspection. The closest inspection station is **District 1-Findlay, 8210 County Road 140, Suite D, Findlay, OH 45840. Phone #419-423-2957**. Please Note: Watercraft must be inspected by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. Make arrangements for inspection through an inspection station at the Maumee Bay Field Office, 1400 State Park Road, Oregon, OH 43618, phone 419-836-6003.

- Take with you to your appointment: the vehicle that requires the inspection; form labeled “**BMV Inspection Request form**”; and the “**Salvage Inspection Receipt**”. The receipt allows the customer to drive the vehicle to/from the Inspection Station without a license plate.
- After you have received your request for record search(s) back from BMV; and, the results from the OSHP inspection, you are now able to complete the APPLICATION FOR ORDER TO ISSUE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE; **this form is an affidavit and requires a signature of a notary public** (any financial institution or auto dealership should have a notary available).
- Submit the completed APPLICATION, the INSPECTION RESULTS; the JOURNAL ENTRY with pertinent information filled out, and all evidence, to the **Wood County Clerk of Courts—Legal Division 2nd Floor, Wood County Courthouse, 1 Courthouse Square, Bowling Green, OH 43402.** Please attach any and all additional information that you have concerning the vehicle in question. **You must complete this step within 60 days of inspection.**
- The filing fee for this process is \$300.00 per Local Court Rule 3.04 (cash, check or credit card) and is payable to the “Wood County Clerk of Courts”. This amount will be collected upon filing of the application. Any funds not used will be refunded at the termination of the case.
- If the COURT ORDER TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE is signed by the Judge, you will be mailed a certified copy. This process will take approximately 90-120 days.
- Take the certified copy of the court order to the **Wood County Clerk of Courts, Auto Title Department** for issuance of a title.
- You will be responsible for sales tax and title fees associated with the certificate of title transaction

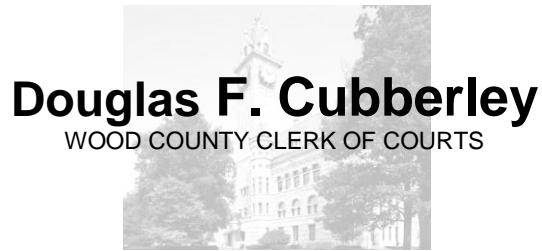
